Adding a series

Edit Books in a Series

Before editing books in a series, check <u>the complete district catalog</u> to make sure someone else hasn't already edited the series. If you redo a series that is already complete, you make additional merging work for Laurel!

How to edit a book in MARC record that is part of a series: <u>245 Tag</u>

- Type the series title. Capitalize the first word and punctuate with a period.
- Type the book or volume number written out i.e. Book one. Capitalize the word "Book" and punctuate with a comma.
- Type the title of the book. Capitalize the first word; follow the title with a space, forward slash.
- Type the author, punctuated with a period.
- If original title began with an article, change the indicator as needed.

245a Abhorsen trilogy. n Book three, p Abhorsen / c by Garth Nix.

246 Tag

- tag 246 Type the title. Capitalize the first word, no punctuation.
- If original title began with an article, drop the article. (The, As, A, etc.)

246a Abhorsen

490 Tag

- tag 490a Type the series title, followed by a space and punctuated with a semi-colon.
- tag 490v Type the series book number. Abbreviate the word "book"-bk. No punctuation after the number.

```
490a Abhorsen trilogy; v book 3
```

(Note: Do not enter initial articles in the 490 tag--Example: In the 245 tag the series would be "A series of unfortunate events," but in the 490 tag it would be "Series of unfortunate events.")

830 Tag

- tag 830a type the series title, followed by a space and punctuated with a semi-colon.
- tag 830v Type the series book number. Abbreviate the word "book"-bk. Punctuate with a period after the book number.
- If the record has an 800 tag it will not be necessary to add the 830 tag.

```
830a Abhorsen trilogy; v bk. 3.
```

(Note: Do not enter initial articles in the 830 tag--Example: In the 245 tag the series would be "A series of unfortunate events," but in the 830 tag it would be "Series of unfortunate events.")

Guidelines

In Destiny, patrons can limit their searches by Reading Grade Level, Interest Grade Level, or both. For the title to appear in search results, the MARC record must contain the following information:
